## MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

The past year was certainly unprecedented and filled with considerable challenges for every business, charity and household. Our hearts go out to those who lost loved ones and we're forever grateful to those who performed miraculously on the front lines keeping many of us out of harm's way.

For the first time in our history, Kids in Camp was not able to support children to attend any of our amazing Ontario Camps Association (OCA) accredited day and overnight summer camps. The \$75,000 which we had allocated in camperships is available for future use as all of the camps that had requested funding were mandated to close due to the pandemic.

Our sights are certainly fixed upon 2021, a year which will be more important than ever for sending children to summer camp. We still have plenty to be thankful for from the past year. We want to acknowledge an incredible group of sponsors, camps, donors and volunteers who supported Kids in Camp. We would also like to highlight several amazing fundraising efforts:

- Mary Catherine Garrod walked 1,000 kilometers to honour the memory of her stepdaughter Ashley Garrod on what would have been her 35th birthday. Ashley was a passionate camper and staff member at Camp Tanamakoon who passed away tragically at the age of 22. To honour her love of camp, Mary Catherine invited supporters to donate to Kids in Camp and raised an incredible \$12,285.

- Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute's annual student dance charity was held over the course of two nights in January, where their theme was "The Circus". The events raised \$5,762 through ticket sales and raffle proceeds.

- Each year the employees of Ada Support Inc. donate leftover points from their credit cards and pool them towards prizes in a holiday raffle, whereby a percentage of the total raised is donated to a charity. This year the proceeds were \$3,167 and the raffle winner, who selects the charity of choice for the year, chose Kids in Camp.

- Bryan Gerber, owner of the Camp Connection General Store, held a Fall promotion selling red bandanas for \$2 each and offered to match \$2 for every one sold. Thanks to his incredible generosity, Kids in Camp received \$2,000 from Bryan in December after selling almost 500 bandanas.

- The Scotiabank Toronto Waterfront Marathon was held virtually in October and, through 26 donors, raised \$1,820 in support of Kids in Camp.

- The OCA held a "Big Night Out" bowling event at its annual conference in February with hundreds of camp delegates in attendance and the event raised an amazing \$1,700 for Kids in Camp.

- Cedar Ridge Camp held its first "Hilly Half" run in September with 50 participants who together raised almost \$1,400. (special thanks to Camp Director Grayson Burke)

- Mary Pat Bradbury crafted face masks in the spring for family and friends. In lieu of accepting payment for her work or materials, she asked them to donate to Kids in Camp and she raised a fantastic \$951.

- Our very own Board Member, Catherine Ross, published "A Camp Director's Diary" during 2020 and, has generously directed half of the proceeds to Kids in Camp.

Looking forward, we know how important it will be for Kids in Camp to support as many children as possible to attend summer camps in 2021. Along with our volunteers and committees, we are hard at work on various fundraising efforts and acquiring campership applications. We're launching a reinvigorated Corporate Sponsorship program and we're excited at the prospect of reaching even greater heights of fundraising.

All these efforts will surely help Kids in Camp reach the \$1,000,000 mark in camperships. We will be immensely proud of this milestone and it's one we could not reach without the incredibly generous support of thousands of people since our inception in 2006.

After a most challenging year for camp-aged children, our Vision and Mission as a charitable organization are even more clear and more important than ever. We look forward to a considerably more positive and fruitful year in 2021.
